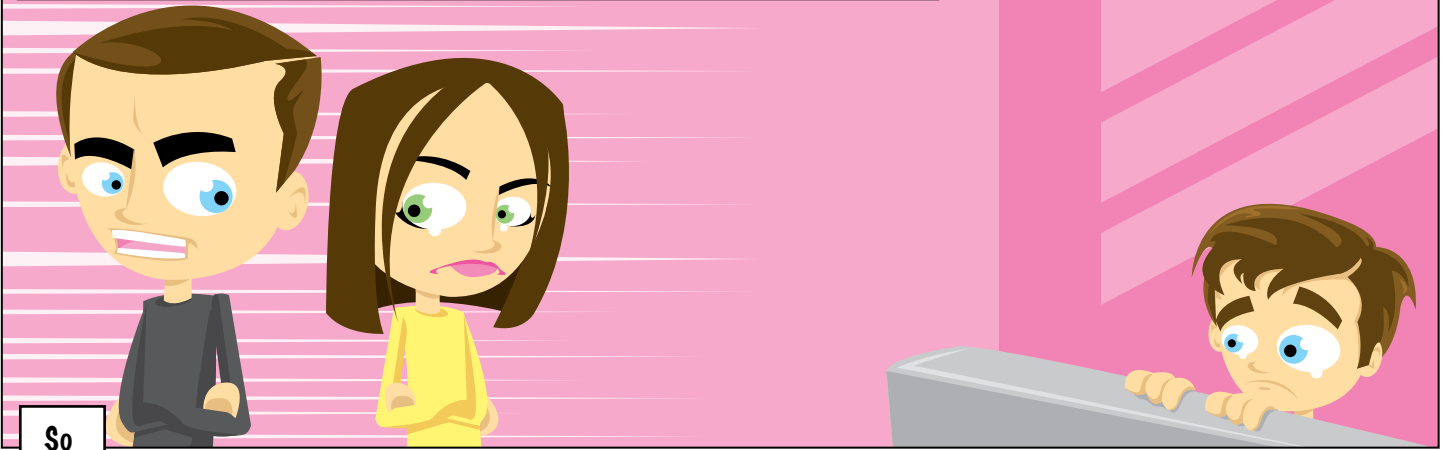
It will help me understand why I am in Care, how I might be feeling and it helps me ask my Foster Carer or Social Worker questions I might have.



WHY AM I IN CARE?

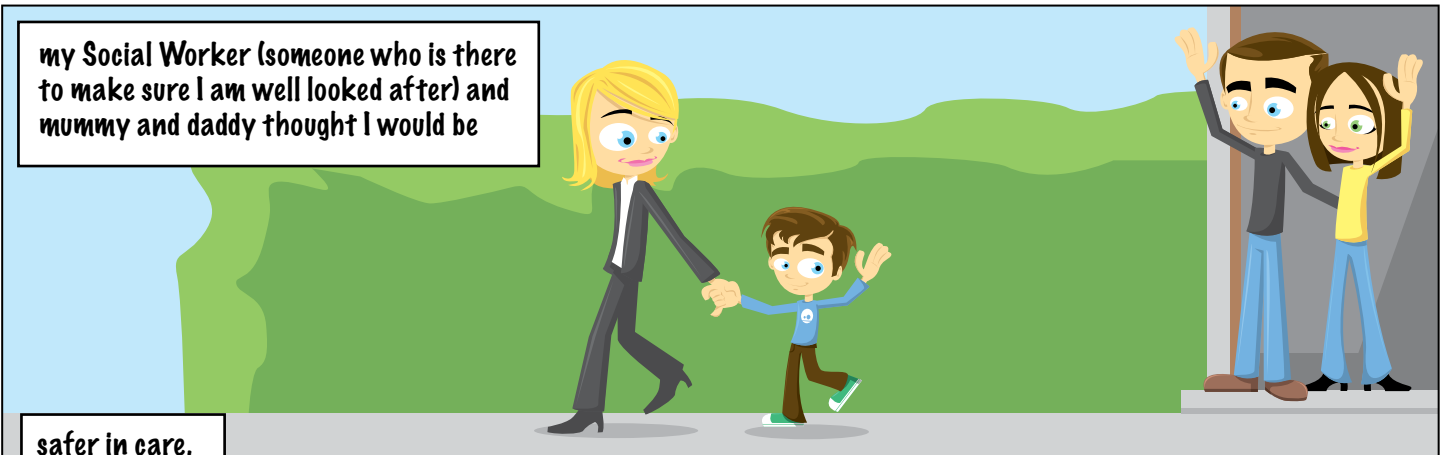


Sometimes mummy and daddy were sad but this had nothing to do with me.



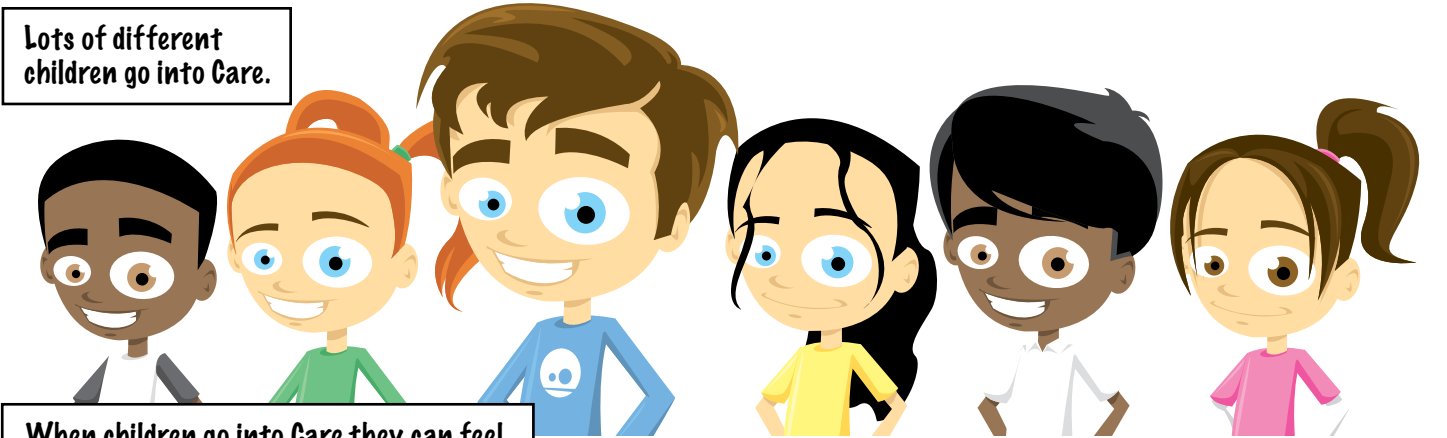
So

my Social Worker (someone who is there to make sure I am well looked after) and mummy and daddy thought I would be

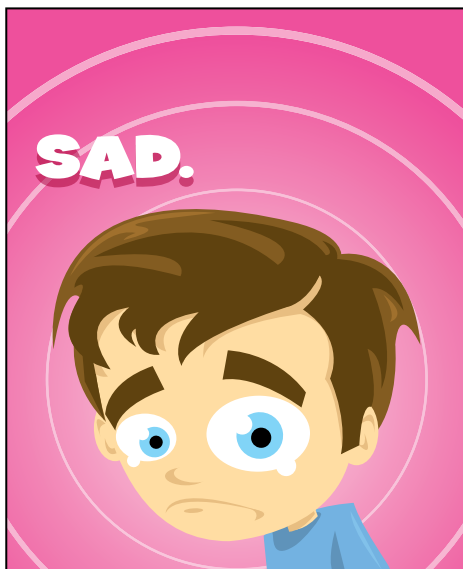


safer in care.

In a Children's Home.. This is where a number of children live together in the same house with adults who are there to look after you.



I live in.. Here you can write or draw where you live.

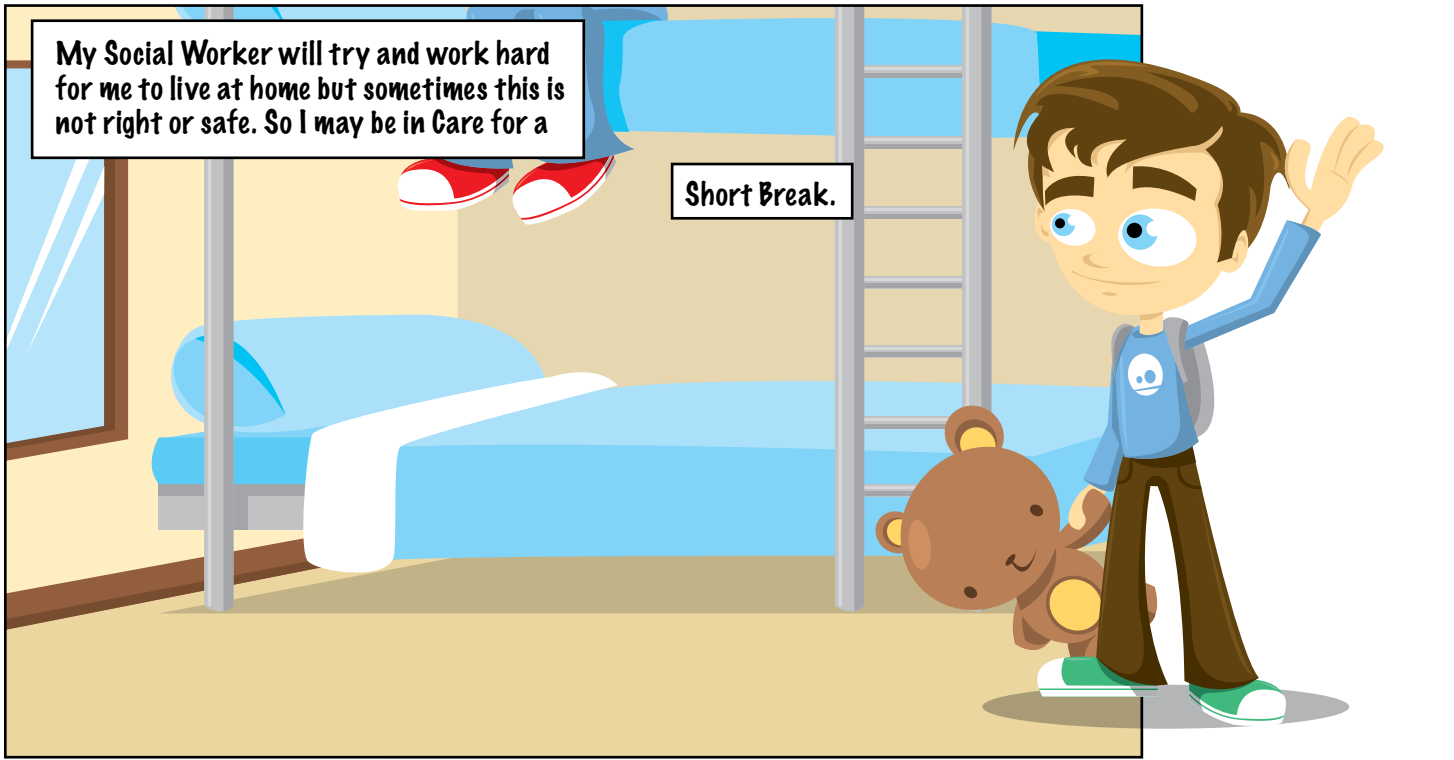
I live with.. Here you can write or draw the people you live with.

Long time with Foster Parents or in a Children's Home.





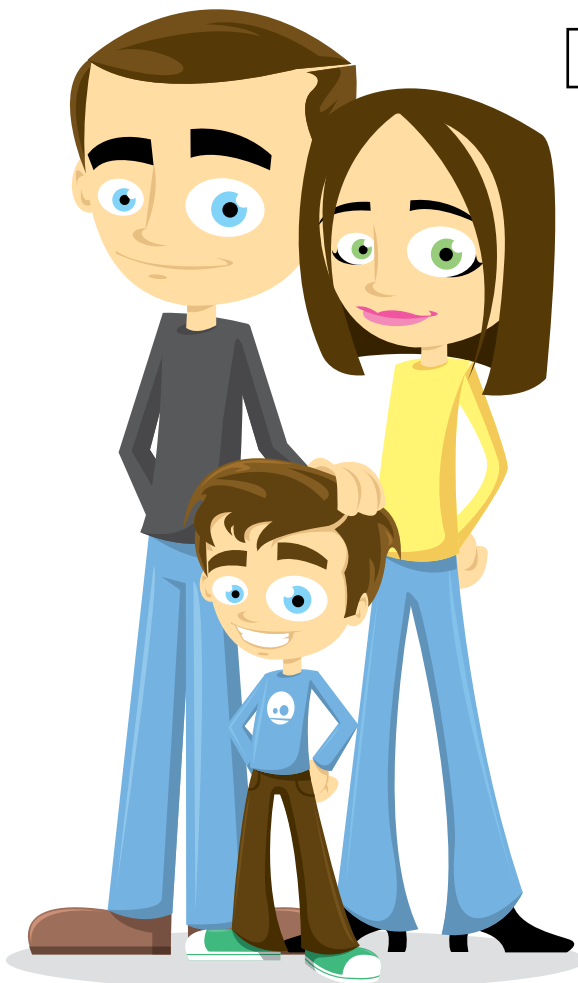

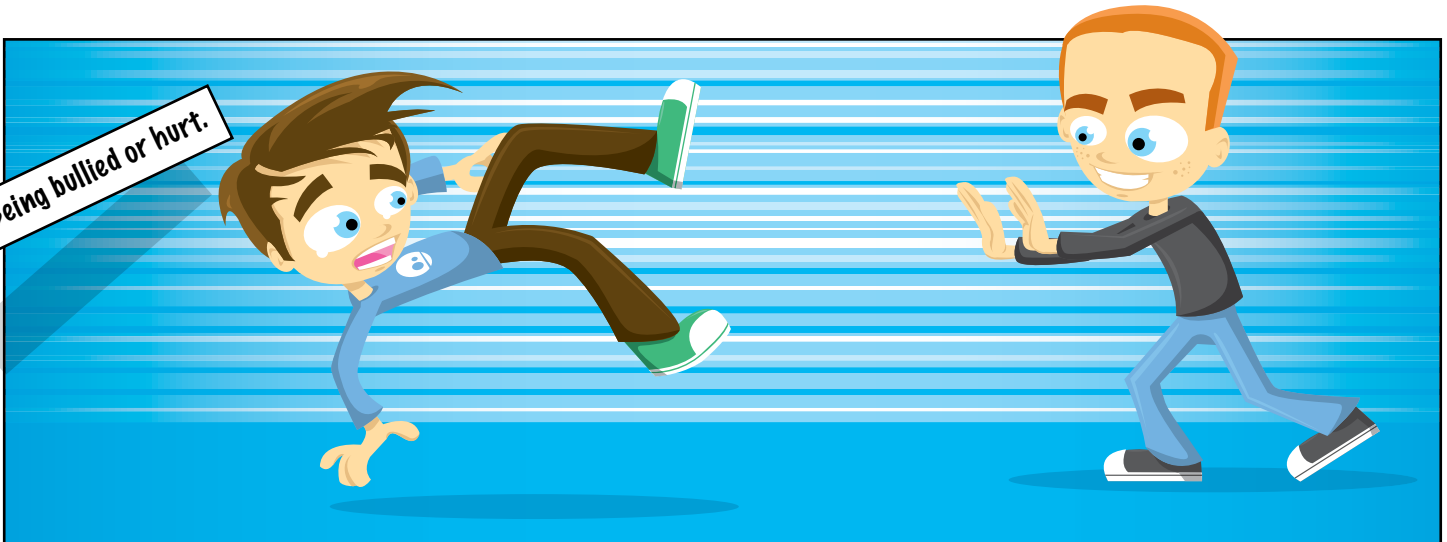
Sometimes I might feel upset because: I am not seeing enough of my family or friends.

Being bullied or hurt.



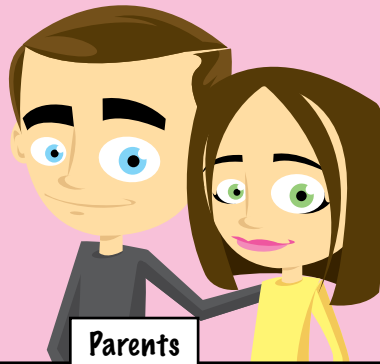
If I have problems I can talk to lots of people..



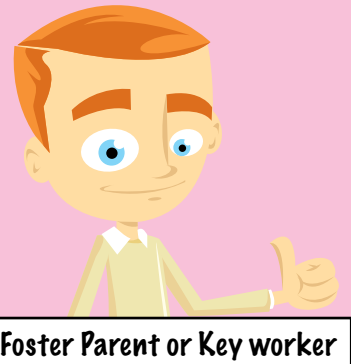

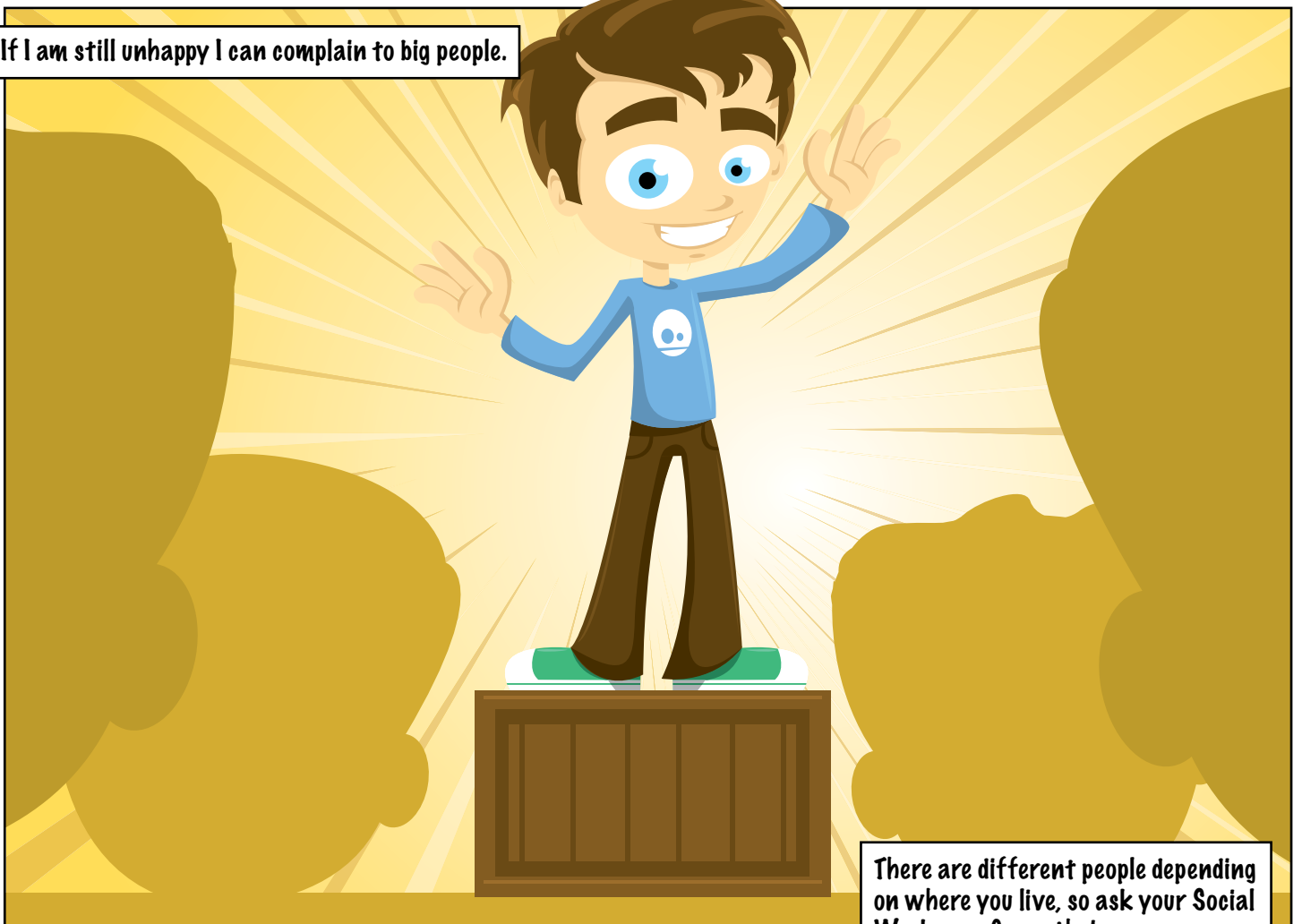

If I am still unhappy I can complain to big people.

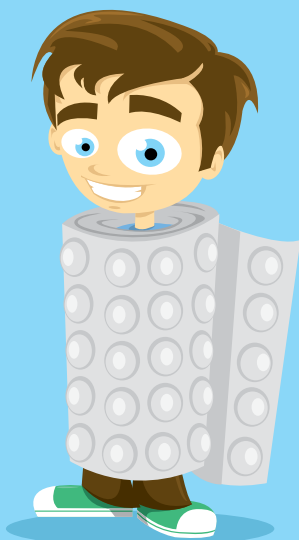


There are different people depending on where you live, so ask your Social Worker or Carer their name.
